The former Head of the Liberal Democrats' Commons Whips' Office, Voyce was involved in the famous spy sags with MP Mike Hancock as the point of contact for complaints about conduct. Voyce has spent a long time in Parliament, working for Liberal Democrat MPs and was influential in helping the Party table amendments during the Charles Bill in 2006.

He began life in Parliament in 2000, working his way up at the Home Office from Press Officer to Deputy Head of News, then he crossed over to the Department of Health where he became Head of News, joining Nick Clegg's team in 2011. He has the challenging job of handling communications for the Deputy Prime Minister, let alone when they are in the Coalition Government, but he has to deal with the communications for Clegg as the Leader of the Liberal Democrat Party. He has to make sure Clegg's message and actions are clearly understood by the press and appreciated in the public eye.

Supporting Jonny Oates in his Chief of Staff role, Colbourne was only appointed to this senior position in January 2014. He had already proven himself a valuable asset through his advising for Nick Clegg since 2010, firstly to the policy unit, then a home and foreign affairs adviser. He was also an advisor back before Clegg was in government from 2002-06. When not working for the Lib Dems, he has worked for the Howard League for Penal Reform, Oxfam International and in various positions promoting intercultural exchanges between Italy and Britain, perhaps teaching him useful co-operation skills for working in a coalition government.
